A public meeting has been announced Sept. 13 for the new Des Moines International Airport Terminal. The meeting is set for 5:30-7 p.m. at the Des Moines Public Library at 1000 Grand Ave.

The existing terminal building was first built in 1948.

Airport officials said aviation planning and design consultants from HNTB Corporation will make a short presentation to start the meeting. The plan calls for a new 14-gate terminal building with the entire cost for the entire project at an estimated \$467 million.

There will also be stations depicting various options for site development, which will allow for your questions and comments.

The Airport Authority is seeking public input on the site options before making a final decision about where to place the new terminal on the existing airport property.
