Gobble tabbed president of state airport association

Greg Gobble, manager of the Keokuk Municipal Airport-Lindner Field and president of Lindner Aviation Inc., has been named president of the Iowa Public Airports Association by its board of directors.

Gobble has served as the manager of the Keokuk Municipal Airport since 2000 and served several years on the IPAA board of directors, most recently as the association's vice president. He succeeded Bob Grierson of the Dubuque Regional Airport at the annual Iowa Aviation Conference in Des Moines April 22.

Gobble also holds a position on the Iowa DOT Office of Aviation Advisory Council. The other officers of the association are Rhonda Chambers-vice president, Fort Dodge Regional Airport, Mike Roe- treasurer, Washington Municipal Airport, and Gayle Brandt- secretary, Northwest Iowa Regional Airport.
