Today is Monday, Oct. 3, the 276th day of 2011. There are 89 days left in the year.

**1861 -- 150 years ago:** Peter Cartwright is lecturing in this city tonight. Give him a rousing house. You will be well paid for it.

**1886 -- 125 years ago:** The Rev. S. S. Cryer of Central Presbyterian Church, Rock Island, tendered his resignation last night for the second time, and the resignation was accepted.

**1911 -- 100 years ago:** John H. Hauberg of Rock Island has been elected president of the Rock Island County Sunday School Association at its 34th annual convention.

**1936 -- 75 years ago:** A heavy frost prevailed in the area last night as the mercury reached a low of 39 degrees at the weather bureau office and 35 degrees at the Moline airport, the coldest since last April 23.

**1961 -- 50 years ago:** A fire prevention school for all building custodians in Rock Island will be held Friday and Saturday at the service building of the Iowa-Illinois Gas & Electric Co.

**1986 -- 25 years ago:** Mississippi River floodwaters today busted a 105-year-old record, swelling to 17.8 feet -- .1 of a foot above the record fall flood that swept through the Quad-Cities area in 1881. The river is expected to continue setting records as it heads toward a crest of 19.5 feet in Rock Island late Monday or early Tuesday.
