	Vehicle Sold for Junk Provide buyer with title properly assigned or obtain a junking	certificate and assign to	o the buyer.		
	 Proof of sale It is good practice to maintain evidence of the sale of the vehicle by: 1. Obtaining a receipt from the buyer stating they have accepted delivery of the car and title (see example below) or; 2. Retaining a copy of the back of the title showing assignment to the buyer or; 3. Filing a "Notice of Sale of Vehicle and Delivery of Title" form 411107 with the county where the vehicle is registered. 				
	RefundMake claim for refund of unused registration fees, if:1. The vehicle was sold or junked and credit was not claime2. The vehicle was traded for another and the excess credit
