The "lowa Transportation Map" is the multicolored official map that is produced by the Department to provide the motoring public with basic information on the location of cities and the highways connecting them. The rule chapter is intended to support the development and use of the lowa Transportation Map. The rule restricts use of the map for personal or professional gain.

Is the benefit being achieved? Please provide evidence.

While rule 761—28.3(307) establishes limitations on the use of the map for purposes of personal or professional gain, the instances of these are extremely rare. Given this, and because no specific lowa Code section authorizes this rule, the intended benefit does not warrant repromulgating this chapter.

The map is distributed without charge, resulting in no direct costs to the public.
