We are pleased to confirm the approval of the Iowa Department of Transportation's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for fiscal years 2025 through 2028. The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) have reviewed the Iowa STIP and the integrated metropolitan Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) for Ames, Cedar Rapids, Council Bluffs, Davenport (Quad Cities), Des Moines, Dubuque, Iowa City, Sioux City, and Waterloo. We find that they meet the necessary federal requirements as stipulated in 23 CFR Part 450.218(b), 23 CFR Part 450.334(a), 23 CFR Part 450, and 49 CFR Part 613.
