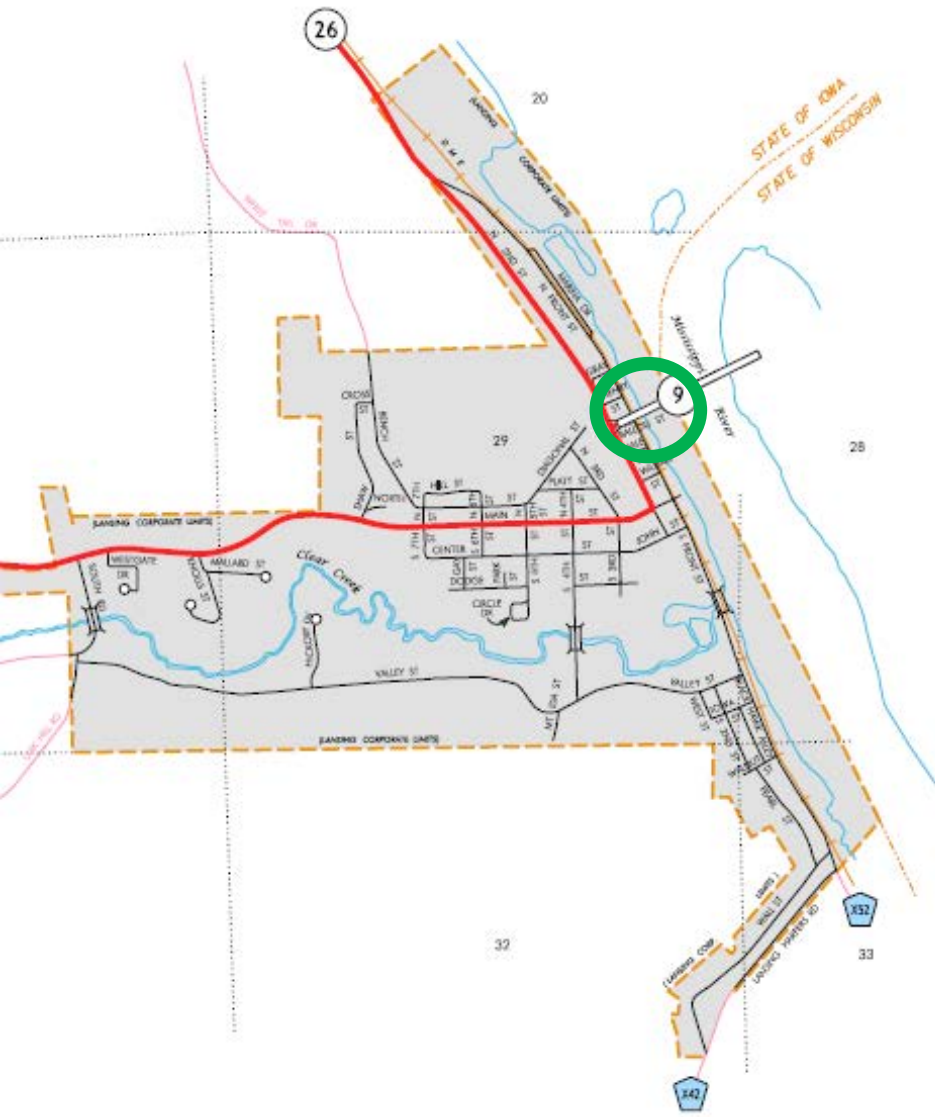

Project Location

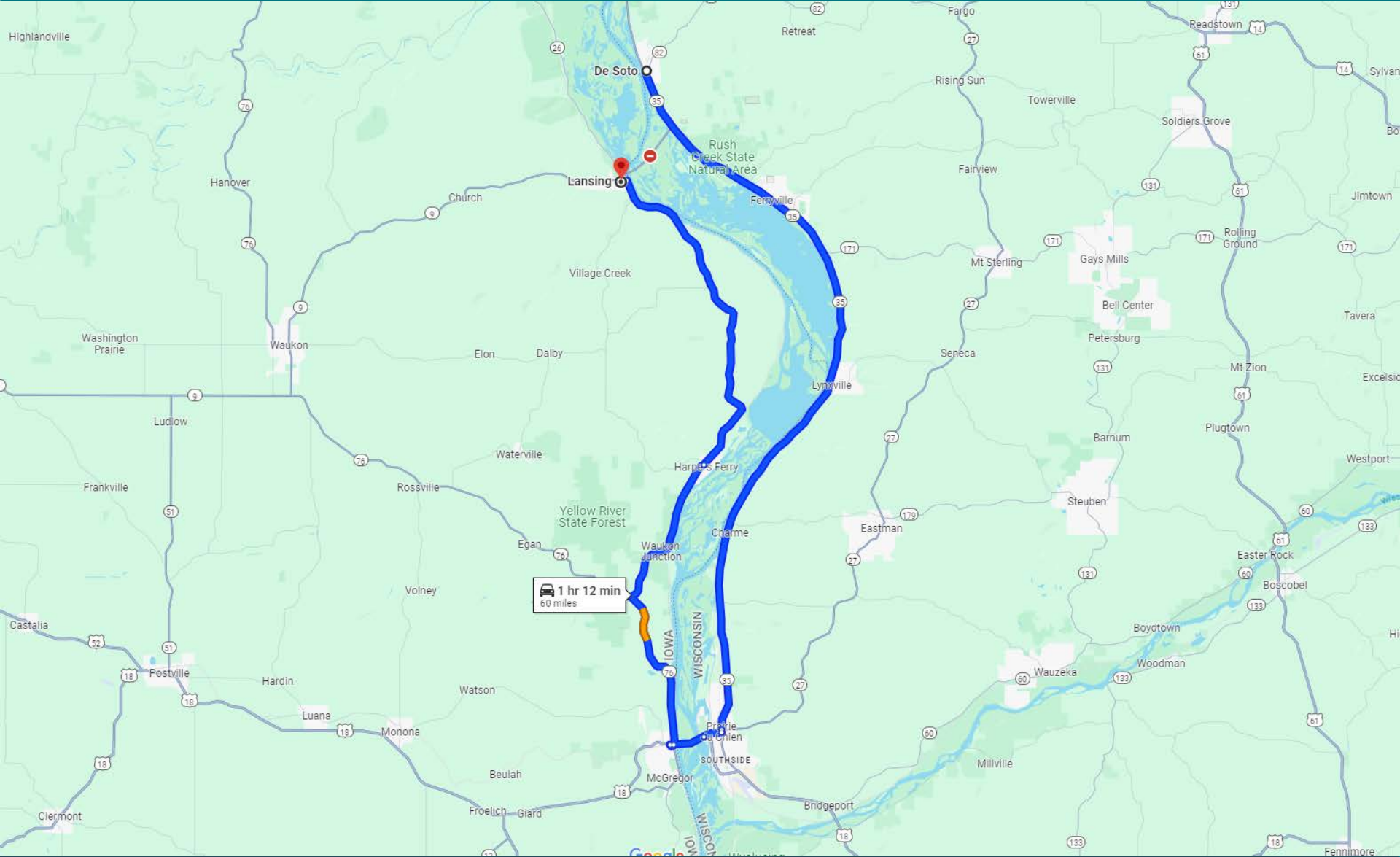
- Lansing, Iowa

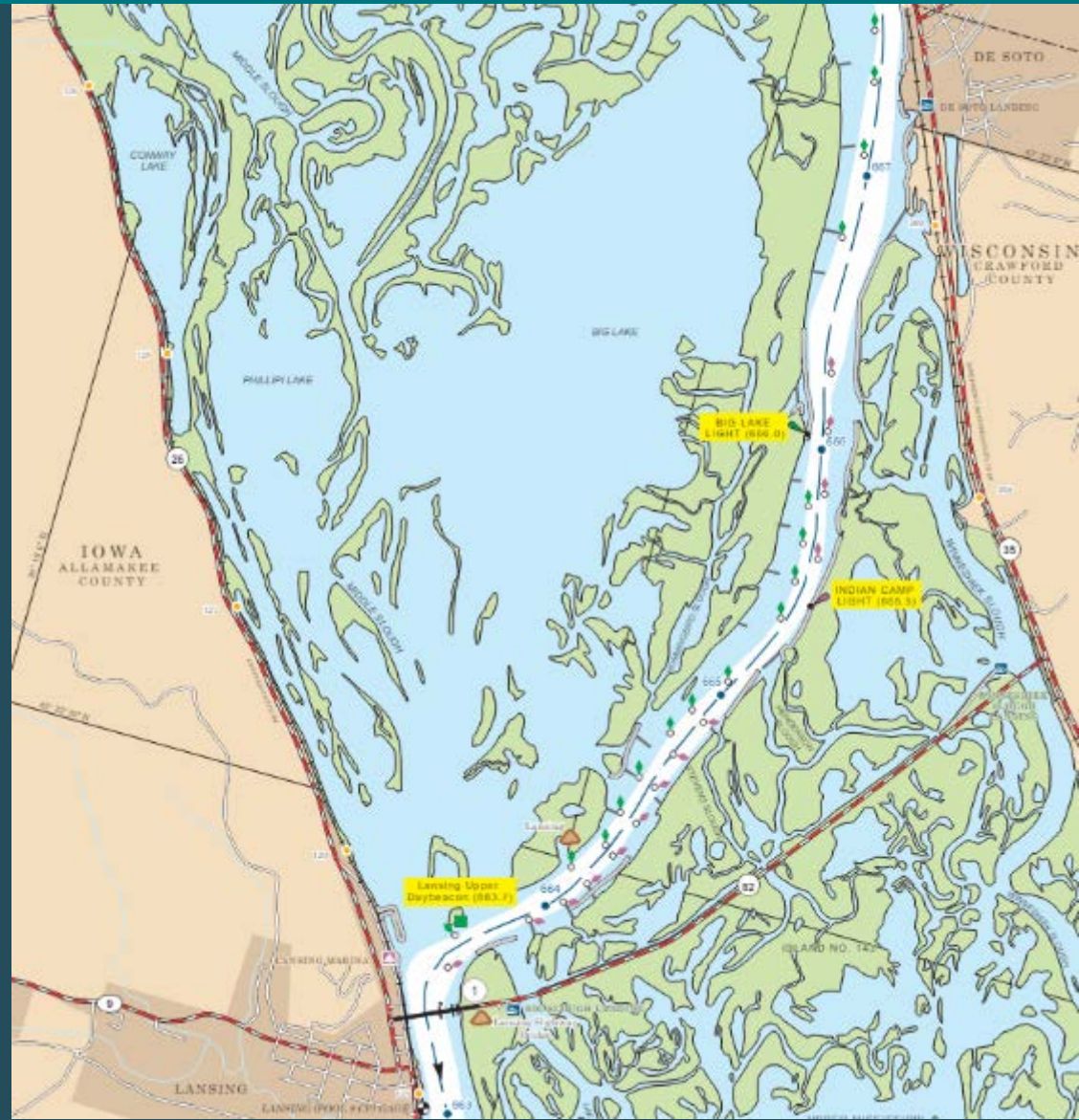

⚠ On Sunday, Feb. 25, the Iowa Department of Transportation was alerted to unexpected movement on the existing Mississippi River Bridge connecting Iowa Highway 9 in Lansing, Iowa to Wisconsin Highway 82 in rural Crawford County, Wisconsin. **The bridge was closed as a result of this discovery.** After thoroughly inspecting the bridge, engineers have determined that the bridge is safe to travel near the work zone.

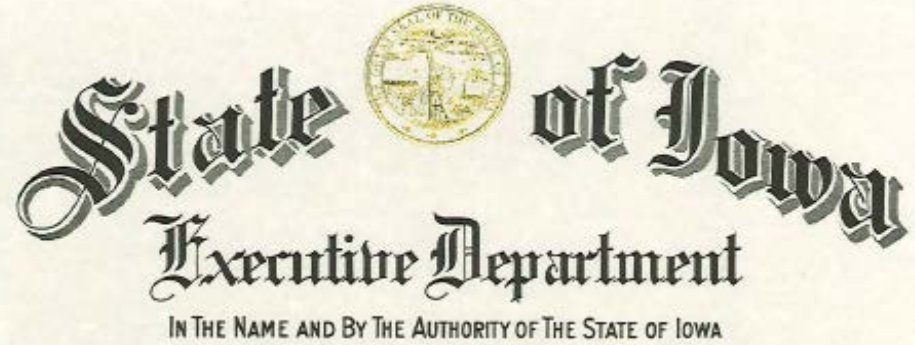

PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2024, the border bridge located in Lansing Iowa on IA HWY 9 that connects to WISCONSIN HWY 35 experienced a sudden structural failure due to an external cause. This failure has caused the bridge to be closed to all traffic until repairs can be completed; and

WHEREAS, Allamakee and Clayton Counties suffered significant impacts from this event; and

WHEREAS, Iowa Department of Transportation officials in the counties affected by this disaster have conducted surveys, assessments and inspections which indicate that federal-aid routes and a bridge have sustained severe damage as the result of this event; and

WHEREAS, federal law as set forth in 23 U.S.C. § 120 (e) and 23 CFR § 668.101 authorizes emergency relief funding for the repair or reconstruction of federal-aid routes that have suffered severe damage as a result of this sudden structural failure, if the governor of the affected state issues a proclamation of disaster emergency in respect to those damages; and

WHEREAS, these conditions threaten the public peace, health, and safety of citizens of the State of Iowa and have damaged and destroyed public property. Because of this, they provide legal justification for the issuance of a Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6 (1).

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KIMBERLY K. REYNOLDS, Governor of the State of Iowa, by the power and authority vested in me by the Iowa Constitution Art. IV, §§ 1, 8 and Iowa Code § 29C.6 (1), and all other applicable laws, do hereby proclaim a **STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY** for Allamakee and Clayton Counties and do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT** the following:

SECTION ONE. I hereby declare this Proclamation of Disaster Emergency to restore essential

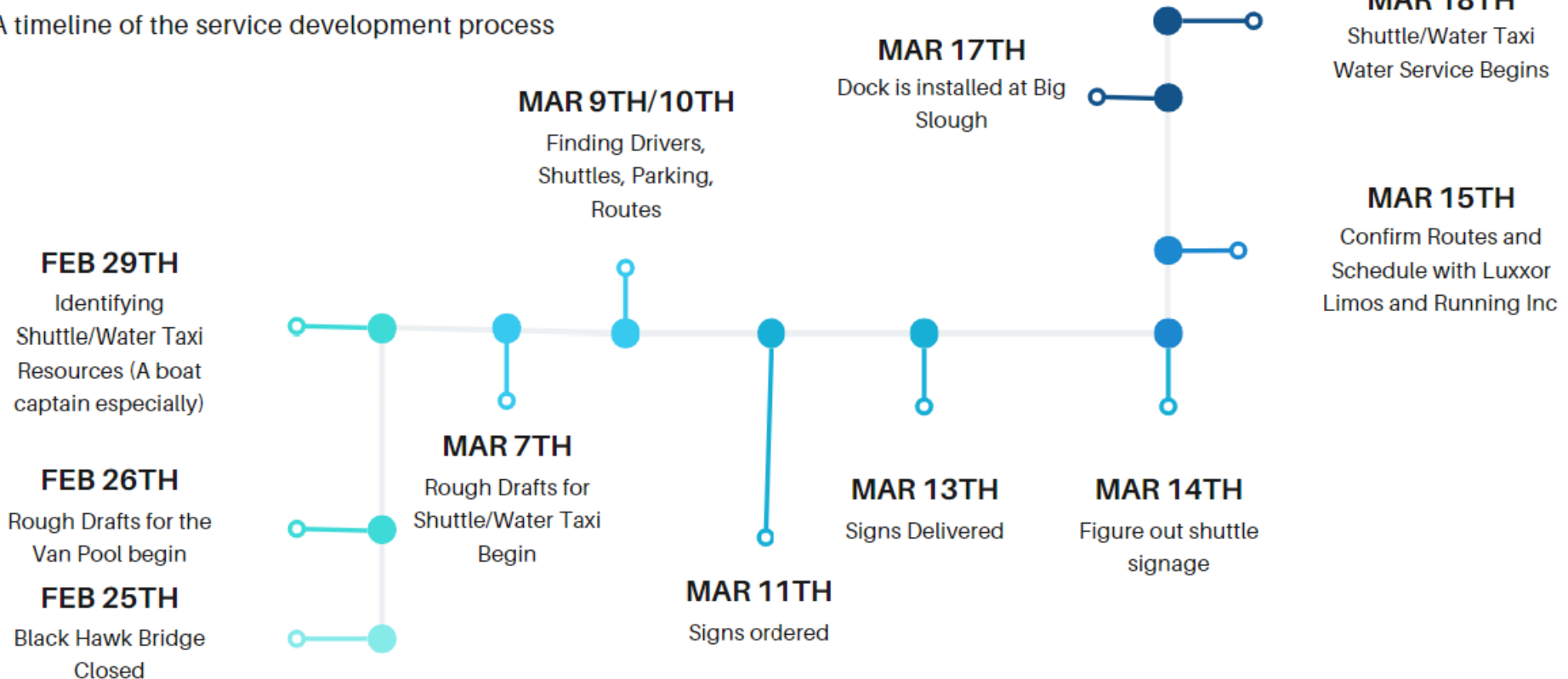

The captain of the taxi, Robert Vavra, highlighted the need for the service. "Of these jobs on this (Iowa) side, they aren't paying enough to do 150 miles a day...so it's darn important to get these people back to work. For not only town of Lansing revenue, but for people that need a job."

With the Black Hawk Bridge's \$124 million replacement being built nearby, scheduled for a 2027 opening, a three-year closure could have decimated downtown Lansing, where businesses count on customers and workers from both sides of the river.
