Transit Capital Programs

Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Program

Direct apportionments:

- Urban (50-200K population) – \$910,902
- Statewide – \$1,750,000
- Council Bluffs – \$793,001
- Davenport (IA/IL) - \$413,401
- Des Moines – \$646,679

Transit Capital Programs

Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Program

Distributed based on Public Transit Management System (PTMS) and availability of local match

State apportionments:

Urban (50-200K Population) – \$910,902

- Two transit systems, five vehicles

Statewide - to be used in non-urbanized areas under 50K population - \$1,750,000

- Ten transit systems, twenty vehicles

Transit Capital Programs

Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Program (CMAQ)

- FY 2016 allocation: \$3,000,000
- Previous CMAQ allocation available for reprogramming: \$42,000
- Three Urban Systems, four vehicles - \$957,721
- Thirteen non-urban transit systems, twenty-five vehicles - \$2,042,279

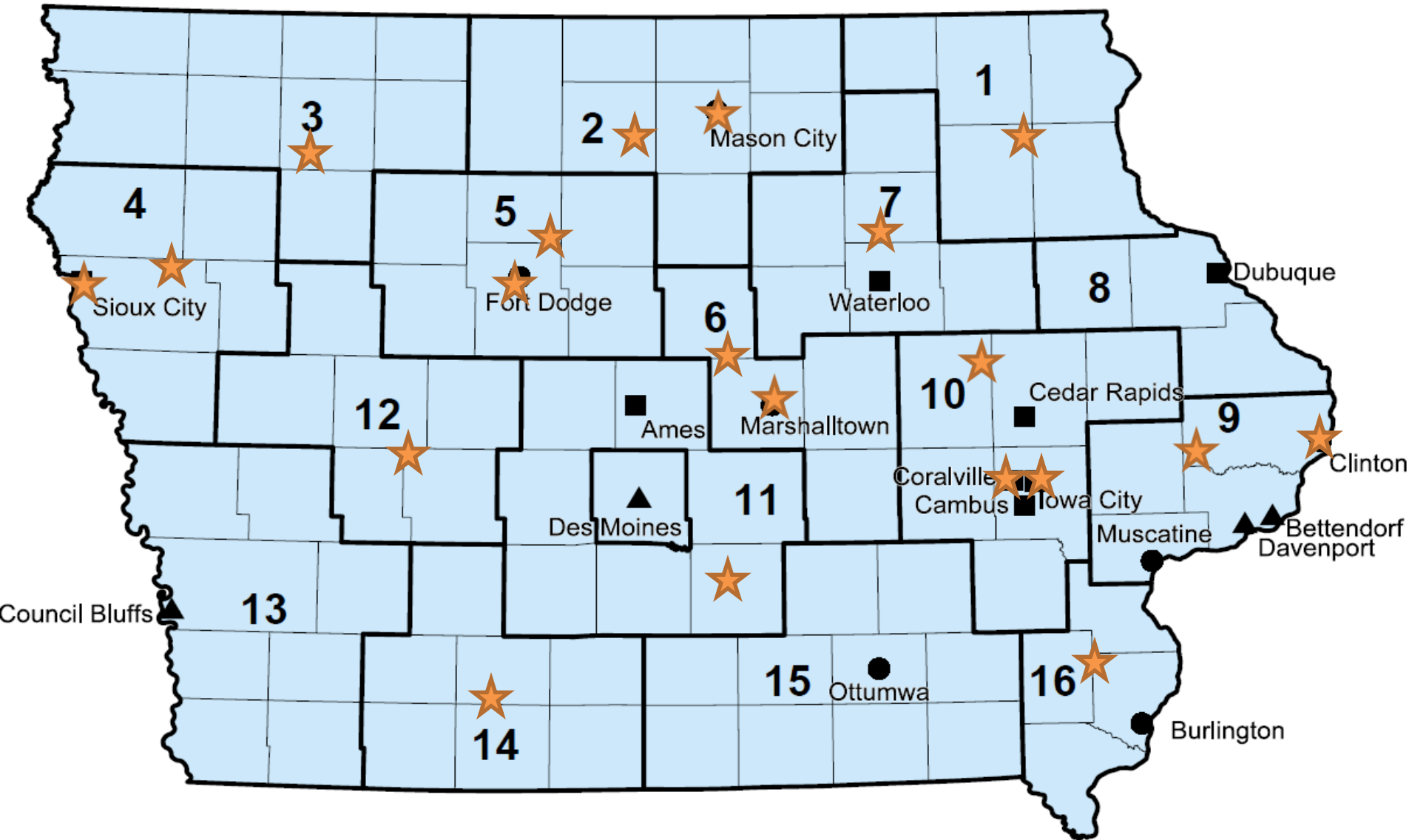
Transit Capital Programs

Summary:

Capital Funds Available - \$5,702,902

Twenty transit systems will be able to purchase fifty-four replacement vehicles

Iowa's Public Transit System



- ▲ 4 Transit Systems in urbanized areas > 200,000 population
- 8 Transit Systems in urbanized areas 50,000 to 200,000 population
- 7 Transit Systems in small urban areas < 50,000 population
- 16 Regional Transit Systems
