

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 12th day of April, 2022 at 12:00 noon at the Council Chambers, 3rd floor, City Hall, 101 First Street SE, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the Cedar Rapids City Council will hold a public hearing to consider the FY23 Consolidated Transit Funding Application from Cedar Rapids Transit to the Iowa Department of Transportation for federal and/or state transit funding assistance.

The FY23 application will include the following projects and estimated funding amounts:

- Section 5307 FTA Operating Assistance for general operating costs - \$3,750,000
- Section 5307 FTA Capital Assistance to replace 1 medium-duty bus - \$164,000 (approximately 80% of the total cost of \$205,000)
- Section 5307 FTA Capital Assistance to replace 2 heavy-duty buses - \$825,600 (approximately 80% of the total cost of \$1,032,000)
- Section 5310 formula allocation to support the general operating costs for ADA complementary paratransit service - \$176,600
- State Transit Assistance for general operating costs - \$702,200

These projects will not have a significant environmental impact on the area and no persons or businesses will be displaced by these activities. These projects are included in the Transportation Improvement Plan prepared by the Corridor Metropolitan Planning Organization.
